Lesson 7 – Questions

What is the gift of the Holy Spirit?

In 1 Corinthians 12, Paul stated that various spiritual gifts came from the same God, Lord, and Spirit. He emphasized that people with different gifts should work together like parts (members) of a body. In chapter 13, he pointed out that love is more important than the spiritual gifts and the key to using the gifts correctly.

1 Corinthians 13

- 1. What was Paul going to show them according to the last verse of chapter 12?
- 2. How might that apply to what he wrote in chapter 13?
- 3. Describe the structure of the first three statements (verses 1-3) and what was his point?
- 4. What does Paul list in verses 4-7?
- 5. What did he say about love at the beginning of verse 8, and what is contrasted to that in the rest of the verse?
- 6. Clearly then, the gifts would cease; what do verses 9-10 say about when they would go away?
- 7. What is the contrast between the parts (verse 9) and the perfect (verse 10), and to what do we apply it?
- 8. How did Paul illustrate that perfection, or completion, in verse 11?
- 9. How did he illustrate it in verse 12?
- 10. What is the view of many believers about when the "face to face" will come?
- 11. According to verse 13, what abides now, but which is greater and why?
